

# Showtime Line Camp Awards

## TEAM AWARDS

**Most Admired:** Each evening your team will have one team vote for Most Admired group of the day. Team will receive a pink Most Admired ribbon.

**Staff Award:** At the end of the week, the staff will vote and select one team for "Staff Award." This is a team who has impressed the staff for the same reasons as your "Most Admired" team -- teamwork, punctuality, showmanship, friendliness, good attitudes, and good behavior. That team will receive yellow ribbon on the last day.

**Team Achievement Plaques:** Your team will be accumulating points toward a score on the last day. Individual Ribbons + Team Score on the camp routine will be averaged and determine your score.

**Home Routine:** The top Home Routines will receive a plaque. The Home Routine score does not add into your score, which is based only on the routines we will teach you this week.

**Supreme Award Plaques:** The highest scoring team from the Home Routine evaluation, Final evaluation, and at officer camp the Choreography evaluation will be awarded this award plaque.

## INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

**Sparkle Ribbons:** The yellow sparkle ribbons are awarded to dancers who have super showmanship. It has absolutely nothing to do at all with what kind of dancer you are, what technique you have, or if you can even remember the routine. All you have to do is flash a super smile while learning and dancing. These ribbons do not count toward your team score.

**All-star Ribbon:** The pink All-star ribbon is awarded to dancers who are performance ready, have good technique, great memory, and smile. Dancers who have been awarded this ribbon have already earned a yellow sparkle ribbon. At the end of the week, each dancer has the option to audition to earn an All-star ribbon, if they have not already earned one. These ribbons do not count toward your team score.

**Miss ShowTime Nominee:** The purple Miss ShowTime nominee ribbons are awarded to the top dancers of the camp. We will be watching you all week in your classes and during the review classes. The nominees will try out for Miss ShowTime on third day, performing the camp routine. The staff will choose the top dancers to be named "Miss ShowTime," these dancers will receive a trophy at the end of the camp. These ribbons do not count toward your team score.

**Kick Club:** This black ribbon is awarded to dancers who have really great kicks, including height, good technique, and stamina. We are going to teach you a kick pattern that we will use for Kick Club tryouts. These ribbons do not count toward your team score.

**Teal Ribbons:** Most Admired Dancer of the Day. Directors award these teal ribbons. Each night, each dancer on your team will have one vote for your Most Admired Dancer of the Day on your own team. These ribbons do not count toward your team score.

**Class Ribbons:** Dancers will be evaluated on routines, individually during camp. Each dancer earn ribbons, with the average point total of the ribbons counting as ½ of your overall team score. Blue is the best ribbon a dancer can receive, followed by red, white, and last green.

Blue Ribbon=100 points

Red Ribbon=90 points

White Ribbon=80 points

Green Ribbon=70 points
